



#### Remove:

- partially, the sections concerned of the door seals.
- the upper seat belt mounting cover.
- the adjusting button (1) (see 59A),
- the upper seat belt mounting bolt (17 spanner).




Unclip the upper part of the lining (inner view) (B).




When refitting the lining, the height adjustment mechanism and its cover on the lining should be positioned in the low position (see 59A).

- the rear door seal.




Remove the seat locking pin (A).



When refitting, begin by sliding the lining panel along the windscreen pillar to fit clip (B) before securing the two clips (A).






Partially remove the door frame seal in the area of the lining panel.

Carefully unclip the two upper clips (A).






#### Remove:

- the four door seals,

- the upper centre pillar linings (see 71A).




Unclip the two clips for each rear quarter panel lining from the contact area with the headlining.


- the sun visors and their retaining clips (see 58B),
- the grab handles and the blanking plugs on the driver's side (see 58A),
- the roof console (see 58C).



Release the two clips (C) securing the courtesy lights positioned next to the rear quarter panel linings.

Disconnect the connectors to remove the courtesy lights.


Remove their housings.



#### Remove:

- the tailgate mounting blanking plugs,
- the upper mountings for the rear sun screens (see below).


Press at (A) and remove the clip (B).



Release the headlining with care.
Cut the adhesive beads using a tool (mastic knife).

Remove the headlining through the luggage compartment.




After protecting the seats, apply adhesive to the headlining as shown below: Seven 4 mm diameter cylindrical beads should be applied between the reference marks on the headlining.


Bring the headlining into the vehicle via the luggage compartment.


Position the headlining in relation to the cut-outs for the sun visors and grab handles.

This operation requires at least three persons.

**NOTE:** For bonding the headlining use a single pot PU adhesive (windscreen adhesive type).









## Remove:

- the rear quarter panel lining (see 71H),
- the rear wing lining (see 71).

Fold the rear seat down and lift the luggage compartment carpet.








Remove the light from the luggage compartment on the left hand side trim panel by pressing clips (C),








Unclip and remove the inertia reel cover (C) with the lower seat belt mounting so the lining may be removed.






Lift the emergency spare wheel housing cover.











Unclip the rear view mirror mounting cover.



Release the two clips (A) and remove the speaker grille.






Lift the tray to release it from its two locating pins on the door.




When carrying out an operation on the electric window switches, the door tray must be removed.



#### Remove:


- the bolt cover (C) (stick a bead of preformed mastic onto the cover and pull to remove the cover without damaging it),
- the door closing handle (D) Torx bolt 20,
- the door opening handle (E) Torx bolt 30.





Unclip and release the trim panel as you go along (use a sharp knife to cut the mastic).

NOTE: an unpicking tool may also be used (see 50B), which facilitates this operation.



Remove the trim panel from its location on the inner weather strip of the front door.


Release blanking plug (F) to permit the connectors at the bottom of the trim panel to be passed through.


Remove the trim panel.

Ensure no adhesive foam for the rear view mirror wiring comes into contact with the location where the door seal is fitted.

When removing or replacing the panel, preformed sealing mastic MUST be used {Part Number : 77 01 423 330).


When replacing a door, we recommend that the door kit be used (see 72A) which includes all the door mountings required for fitting trim to a new door.






#### Remove:

- the bolt cover (A) (stick a bead of preformed mastic onto the cover and pull to remove the cover without damaging it),
- the door closing handle (B) Torx bolt 20 and pull the handle upwards to release it from the trim panel,
- the door opening handle (C) Torx bolt 30 (see 51B).
- the window winder handle (see 51A).




On the rear door, remove the two bolts mounting the door tray, Torx 20.

IMPORTANT: the door tray is an integral part of the trim panel. It is removed with the trim panel.





#### REPOSE



When refitting the trim panel, insert the upper section into the inner weatherstrip on the rear door and also into the two retaining clips (D) under the fixed window.



Remove the four bolts (B) (Torx 20).




When refitting, take care to ensure that on the right hand side, the third rear seat belt is on top of the shelf, not underneath it.






Head restraint guides: After removing the trim from the seatback, press on the tabs and remove the guides.
